DUCTION LAST WEEK AS 19 PER-CENT ABOVE THE WEEK BEFORE AND 8 PERCENT ABOVE LAST YEAR. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 10 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.
