WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; JULY 21-27, 1988. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS AT VIRGINIA AUCTION LAST WEEK WERE \$1.00-3.00 HIGHER FOLLOWING MIDWEST PRICES WHICH WERE STEADY TO \$7.75 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.00-3.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER. THE BOXED BEEF CUT-OUT VALUE ON TUESDAY WAS \$105.69 DOWN \$1.00 FROM LAST TUESDAY.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA LAST WEEK WERE STEADY TO \$5.00 HIGHER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY. BEEF PRODUCTION THIS WEEK WAS 4 PERCENT BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 5 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 7 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES LAST WEEK IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO WEAK. VEAL AND CALF SLAUGHTER WAS 4 PERCENT BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 10 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 17 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$2.00 LOWER TO \$1.00 HIGHER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO WEAK. LAMB SLAUGHTER WAS 6 PERCENT BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 2 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOGS IN VIRGINIA LAST WEEK WERE \$1.00-1.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.50 HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$4.00 HIGHER. PORK PRODUCTION WAS 1 PERCENT ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 18 PER-

CENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

THE RICHMOND HOG MARKET CLOSED 50 CENT TO 1.50 HIGHER THAN LAST TUESDAY WITH BARROWS AND GILTS US 1-4 200-240 LBS AT \$43.00-44.00 PER CWT.

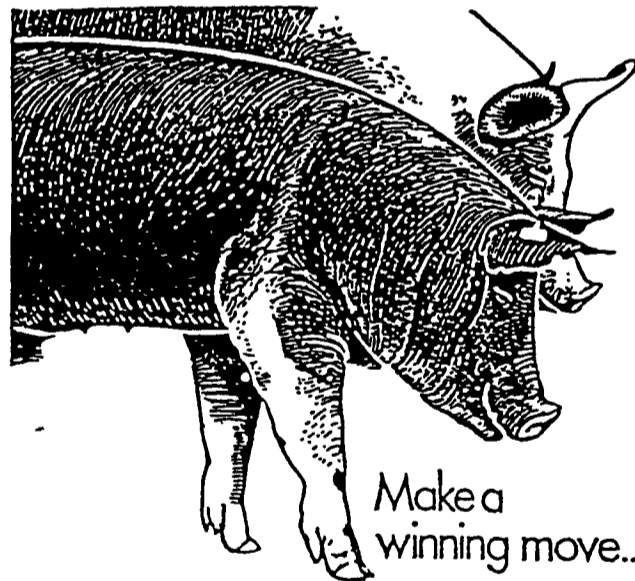
