MARKETS IN REVIEW; JULY 28-AUG. 3, 1988. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS LAST WEEK WERE STEADY TO \$7.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MIXED 75 CENT LOWER TO \$5.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 HIGHER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$1.50 LOWER. THE BOXED BEEF CUT-OUT VALUE ON TUESDAY WAS \$104.35 DOWN \$2.33 FROM LAST TUESDAY.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA LAST WEEK WERE STEADY TO \$4.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1 PERCENT HIGHER THAN LAST WEEK BUT 5 PERCENT HIGHER THAN LAST YEAR. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 4 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES LAST WEEK IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST CARCASS PRICES

WERE \$2.00-9.00 HIGHER. VEAL AND CALF SLAUGHTER WAS 9 PERCENT ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND LESS THAN 1 PERCENT BELOW LAST YEAR. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 16 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$4.00-5.00 LOWER. LAMB SLAUGHTER WAS 3 PERCENT HIGHER THAN LAST WEEK BUT ONLY 1 PERCENT HIGHER THAN LAST YEAR. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOGS IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT TO \$1.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$6.00 HIGHER. PORK PRODUCTION WAS 6 PERCENT BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 13 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

\$41.50-42.50 PER CWT.

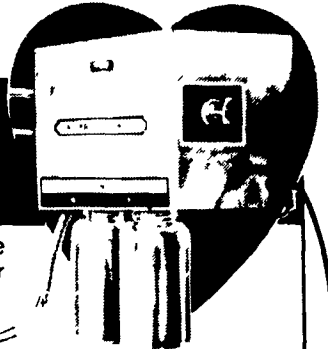
