Wool Show To Debut At 1988 NAILE

LOUISVILLE, KY — The 15th Annual North American International Livestock Exposition (NAILE) is scheduled at the Kentucky Fair & Exposition Center (KFEC) November 5-19, Harold Workman, NAILE executive director, announced today the NAILE Executive Committee has approved a new event for the 1988 Expo. "For the first time, the NAILE will host a Wool Show," he said. "Fleeces from 14 breeds of purebred sheep will be judged for quality, evenness, condition, character, length and strength. Premiums totaling \$1,550 will be awarded to the top ram and ewe fleeces in each breed, and grand champion and reserve grand champion fleeces will be selected." Wool competition will take place during the NAILE Sheep Show, November 12-18.

According to the Wool Show Superintendent Marilyn Fischer, of Simpsonville, KY, all fleeces

entered must be from purebred sheep. She said, "Fleeces entered must have been removed from purebred sheep registered in their respective Registry Associations. All wool exhibited must be shown within the year it was shorn. In addition, all fleeces entered must have been grown or sheep owned by the exhibitor and shown in his or her name." The Wool Show entry fee is \$5 per fleece. Sheep breeders must submit entries for the show by October 1, and all wool must be in place by 6:00 p.m., Friday, November 11. Entry forms may be obtained by contacting the NAILE offices, P.O. Box 36367, Louisville, KY 40233; 502/588-3166.

Workman noted that fleeces may be sent prepaid, by mail or express, to: N.A.I.L.E. Wool Show, Kentucky Fair & Exposition Center, Phillips Lane at Freedom Way, Louisville, KY, 40213. NAILE management will ensure

that all fleeces are properly displayed. Each fleece sent to NAILE offices must be properly tagged, including breeder's name, sheep breed, sex, and class entered.

The NAILE is the largest allbreed, purebred livestock show in the world. The giant, two-week expo annually attracts livestock exhibitors from across the United

States and visitors from many foreign countries. Nearly 15,000 livestock entries will compete for more than \$300,000 in premiums and awards.

Seber also assisted with club activities and events as a teen leader and completed projects in sheep and dairy
