Don also was named to receive the Premier Exhibitor Award while Allegan Farms, Genesee, received the Premier Breeder Award. Snyder Farms, Westfield, took second place in premier breeder, while Baileyview Farm, Ulysses, came in a close second in the Premier Exhibitor competition. One hundred eighteen dairy animals and 28 beef were shown.

Other Holstein winners included Jesse Erway, Coudersport, whose senior heifer calf, Betsy Inspirate Bertha-Red-ET took junior champion female, while the reserve champion Highlander Enhancer Misty, came from Comstock Farm, Port Allegany RD.

Top winners in each class were: Junior heifer calf, Del Hollow Pasta Jet-ET, shown by Jesse Erway; intermediate calf, Highlander Enhancer Misty, of Comstock Farm; senior heifer calf, Betsy Inspirate Bertha-Red ET, shown by Jesse Erway. Top summer yearling was Portage Pride Maple Miller, shown by Janet Matthews, while Bailey View Farm took first place in the junior yearling heifer class with C. Trout Spring Joe Lola. Intermediate Yearling heifer first place went to Greg Outman, Ulysses, with So-No-Co Bandit, while first place in senior yearling heifer went to Jesse Erway with Del-Hollow TT Tina Lynn-Red-

Comstock Farms took the junior get of sire award for three animals under two years old, all by the

Ansdale Farm, Ulysses, took first place for dry cow four years and under with Royale Josh Crown Eliza. The Junior two-year-old class was won by Ken Smoker of Allegen Farms with Allegen Tony Darla. Donald Thompson took first place in the senior two year old class with Snyder Wiseman Star Sally. First place in threeyear-old went to Bailey View Farm with Lock-Bar Ultimate

The champion in the 4-year-old class was the grand champion, Don Thompson's Jim-Slocums Triple Charo. Leo Tice took first place in the six years and over class with F&F Lucky Creek Candy.

The reserve grand champion female and reserve senior champion female was Allegen Farms Allegen Chairman Colene. Allegen also took first place in the best 3 females, any age, bred and owned by exhibitor, while Donald

Thompson took first place in dairy herd, 3 cows that have freshened, all owned by one exhibitor. First place for produce of dam went to Allegen Farms while Don Thompson took the dam and daughter class. Orton Kinney, Port Allegany RD took the get of sire class.

Grand champion bull was shown by Leon Tice, Coudersport.

Grand champion and senior champion Brown Swiss was Conover Hill Dona Gertrudis, a 6-yearold and over animal shown by Diane Prince, Shinglehouse. Diane also had the reserve champion, Prinfam Impro Foxy Landy, a 3-year-old. Diane also took first place in dam and daughter class. Patrick Prince took first place in dry cow 4-year & under and two year old Brown Swiss classes.

The senior and grand champion female Jersey was Lost Hill Benjamin Lola, shown by Rynell Barker, Ulysses, and it was also the top junior two-year-old. The reserve champion and reserve grand champion female was shown by Jeremiah Kosa, Ulysses, and was named Torreys Little Bambi, Jeremiah also took the best udder class and the dam and daughter class.

First place in the junior heifer jersey class went to Kent Charles Barker with Jer-Sweet Irish Creek Saint Ruby. Justin Osgood of Wellsville, N.Y. took first place in the intermediate heifer calf class with S.V. Reber Lassie, and the top senior yearling heifer was EDKO Yolanda Bossy Beauty shown by Jeremiah Kosa. The junior champion female was Kent Barker's calf, while Justin Osgood's was named reserve champion female.

In the junior heifer calf class first place went to Stephanie Carpenter with SAC Pandora, a purebred simmental, followed by Mark D. Mesler with Topsee, a Hereford.

First place in the senior heifer calf class went to Nedra Matthews




