## USDA Proposes Rules To Implement Poultry Amendments To P&S Act

WASHINGTON, D.C.--The U.S. Department of Agriculture has proposed changes in rules to implement recent amendments to the Packers and Stockyards Act providing payment protection to growers and sellers of live poultry.

The amendments require that payment for live poultry purchased in a cash sale must be made by the close of the next business day, and that payment for poultry produced under a growing arrangement must be made before the close of the

15th day following the week in which the poultry is slaughtered.

The amendments further require that live poultry, inventories, receivables and proceeds of live poultry dealers be held in trust to (Turn to Page F20)


