26. Absentee ballot return envelopes, containing ballot and registration/certification statements, must be signed by the voter and mailed so as to be received in the County Extension office serving the county of voter residence, by close of business on September 1.

Referendum voting will be conducted in the county extension offices, during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Voting will be conducted on two days, September 7 & 8.

Any person who has raised two or more hogs for sale during the representative time period of November 1, 1986, through September 6, 1988 is eligible to vote. Importers of porcine animals, pork or pork products during the representative time period can vote. 4-H, FFA and other youth who owned market hogs also are eligible to vote.

The Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service will count ballots, determine the eligibility of challenged voters and ballots and report referendum results.

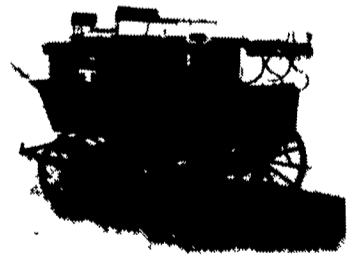

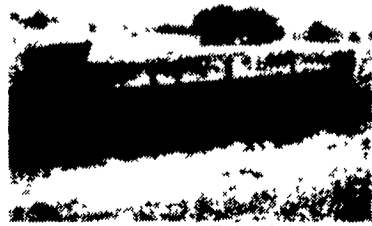
