Virginia Weeklv Richmond, Va. Thursday, August 11, 1988 FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS WERE STEADY TO \$5.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST. PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$275 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT TO \$1 00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES-WERE STEADY TO \$1 00 HIGHER THE BOXED BEEF CUT-OUT VALUE **ON TUESDAY WAS \$106.72 THIS WAS** \$2.37 HIGHER THAN LAST TUESAY.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$200 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-2.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUC-TION WAS 3 PERCENT BELOW LAST WEEK AND 1 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 6 POUNDS HEAVIER SIEADY IN VIRGINIA LAST WEEK AS NATIONAL CALF CARCASS REMAINED STEADY. VEAL AND CALF SLAUGHTER WAS 6 PERCENT ABOVE LAST WEEK AND 6 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 23 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$3 00 HIGHER. LAMB SLAUGHTER WAS 1 PERCENT BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 2 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOGS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER AS **MIDWEST PRICES WERE 25-75 CENT**

LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE 75 CENT TO \$3.00 HIGHER EXCEPT BELLIES WHICH WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER. PORK PRODUCTION WAS 5 PERCENT ABOVE LAST WEEK AND 15 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR. THE RICHMOND HOG MARKET




