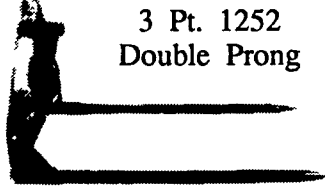
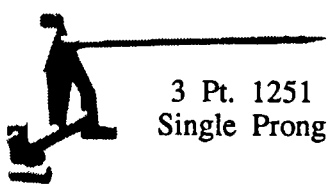
In the junior champion spot was Eugene Kreitzer, also of Northern

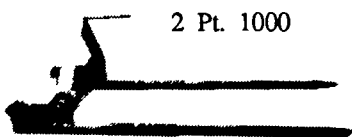

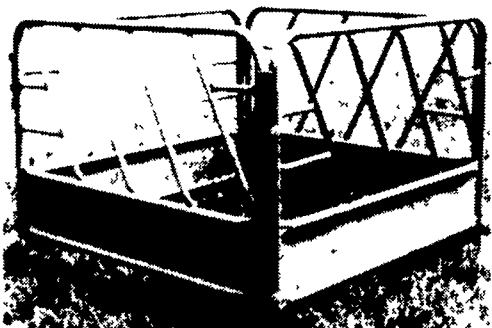

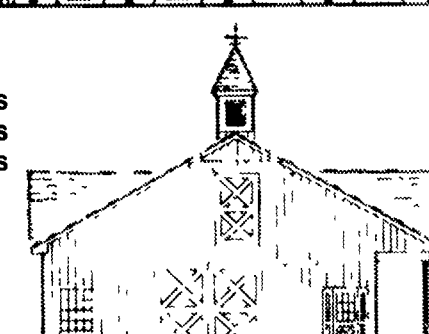
