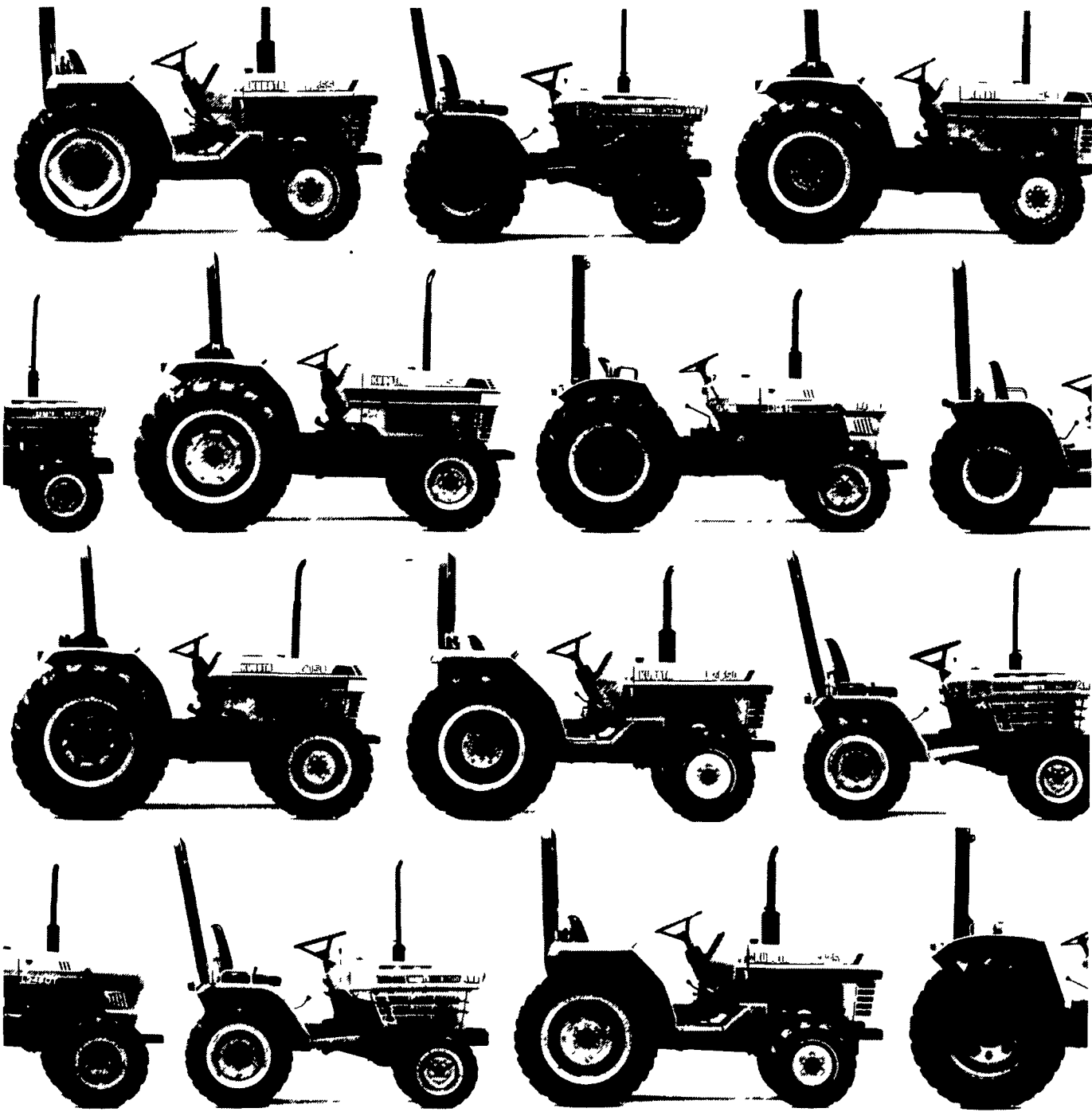
## WAYNE COUNTY DHIA June 1988

Robert Fielding & Son, #5 Lake Ariel, had the leading dairy herd in the Wayne County Dairy Herd Improvement Association in the June test period, according to the Cooperative Extension Service. The herd of 31 Holsteins had a rolling herd average of 20,348 pounds of milk and 819 pounds of butterfat.

Other top herds were: Kevin Burleigh, #1 Pleasant Mount, 20,570 milk and 759 fat; Charles P. Dennis, #2 Honesdale, 19,166 milk and 728 fat; Jack & Ella Chyle, Pleasant Mount, 20,911 milk and 724 fat; James Slocum, #3 Susquehanna, 17,758 milk and 694 fat; Kinghill Farm, Starrucca, 17,751 milk and 691 fat; Rowe Brothers, #2 Honesdale, 18,347 milk and 687 fat; Highland Farms, St. Rt. Honesdale, 19,341 milk and 676 fat; E. W. Lepro, #2 Thompson, 17,760 milk and 671 fat; and Clearfield Farms, #2 Honesdale, 17,418 milk and 654 fat.

The cow completing the highest lactation of 305 days or

less during the June test period was a five year old Holstein owned by Kevin Burleigh, #1 Pleasant Mount. "Peggy" produced 23,382 pounds of milk and 974 pounds of butterfat.
