

Tax Preparation Workshops Offered By Penn State

UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre)
— While the April 15 deadline to file income tax returns may seem far away, now is not too soon to learn the latest about how the Internal Revenue Service is interpreting provisions of the Tax Reform Act of 1986.

In October, the Cooperative Extension Farm Management

program at Penn State is conducting regional Federal and State Income Tax Preparation Workshops in Lancaster, Williamsport, Souderton, Bedford, Pittsburgh, and Meadville.

Tax accountants, tax preparers, farmers, owners of small businesses and other individuals who are looking for current information

about charges in tax filing procedures and the latest IRS interpretations of the new law, can register now for a Tax Preparation Workshop in their area. Two-day workshops will be offered on the following dates.

— Lancaster, October 11 and 12 — Farm and Home Center, 1383 Arcadia Road.

— Williamsport, October 13 and 14 — 234 Montgomery Pike, South Williamsport.

— Souderton, October 17 and 18 — Family Restaurant, Route 113, Franconia.

— Bedford, October 20 and 21 — Arena Restaurant, Route 220.

— Pittsburgh, October 25 and 26 — Days Inn Motel, 300 Taren-

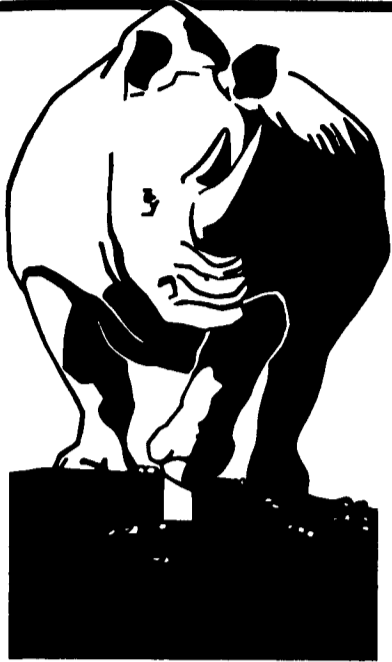
tum Bridge Road, New Kensington.

— Meadville, October 27 and 28 — David Mead Inn, 455 Chestnut Street.

Topics for discussion include tax changes affecting individuals, taxation of clergy and church personnel, net operating losses, farm tax issues, and the tax impact of pension distributions. In addition, the October workshop will feature a demonstration of computerized tax filing as well as presentations about specific state and federal charges.

Pre-registration is recommended, although not required. The registration fee of \$100 includes workshop reference materials, noon lunches and refreshments at breaks. Those who register before September 30 will receive a \$25 discount.

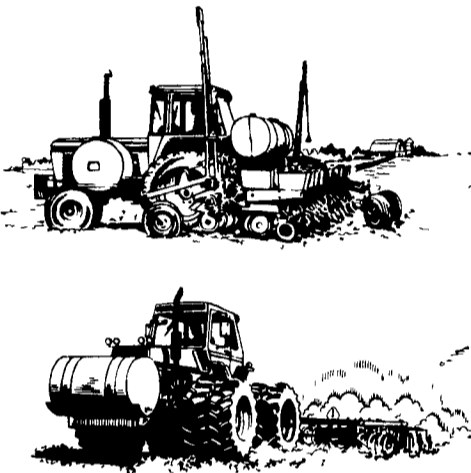
