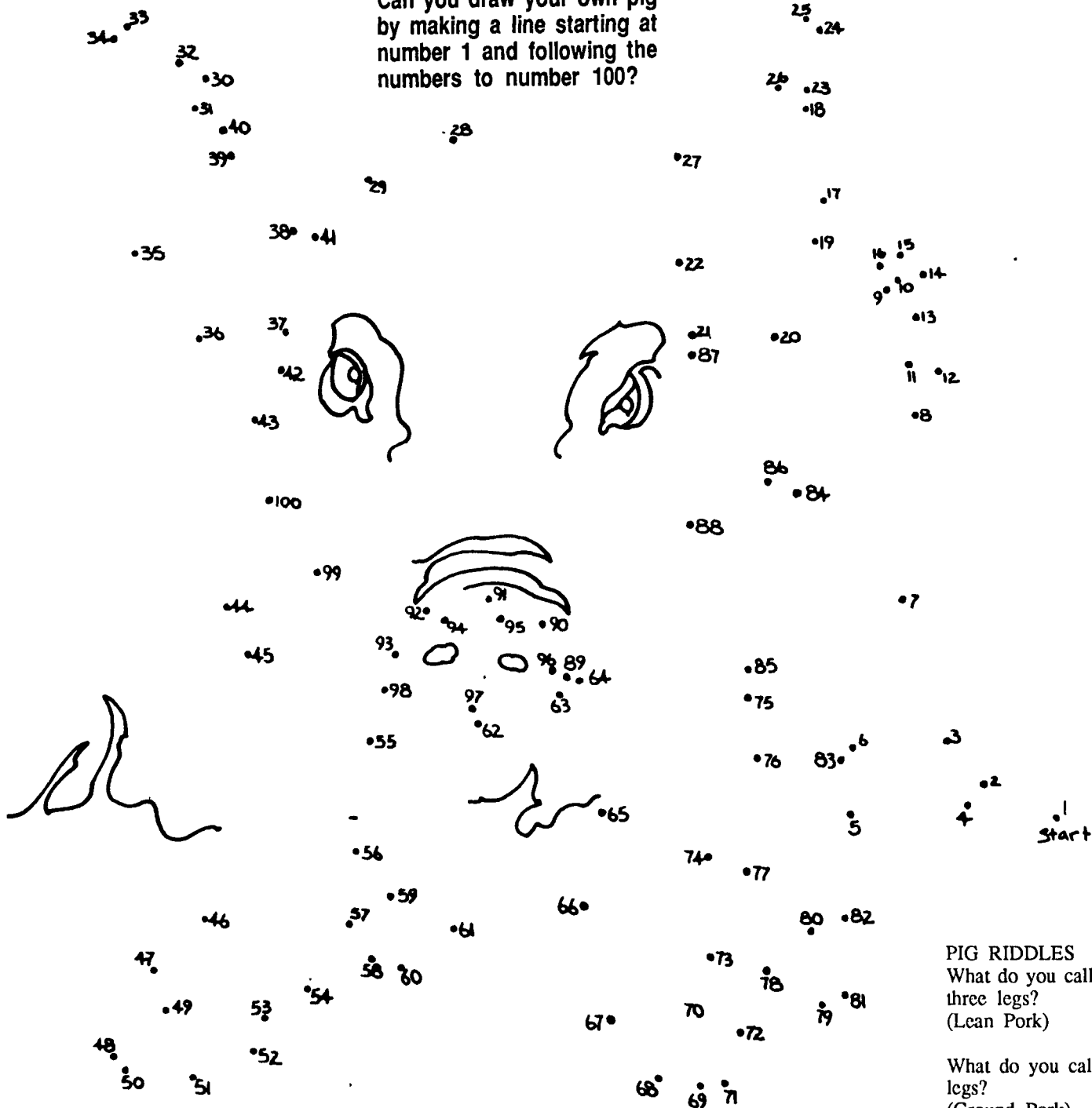


# Kids' KOrner

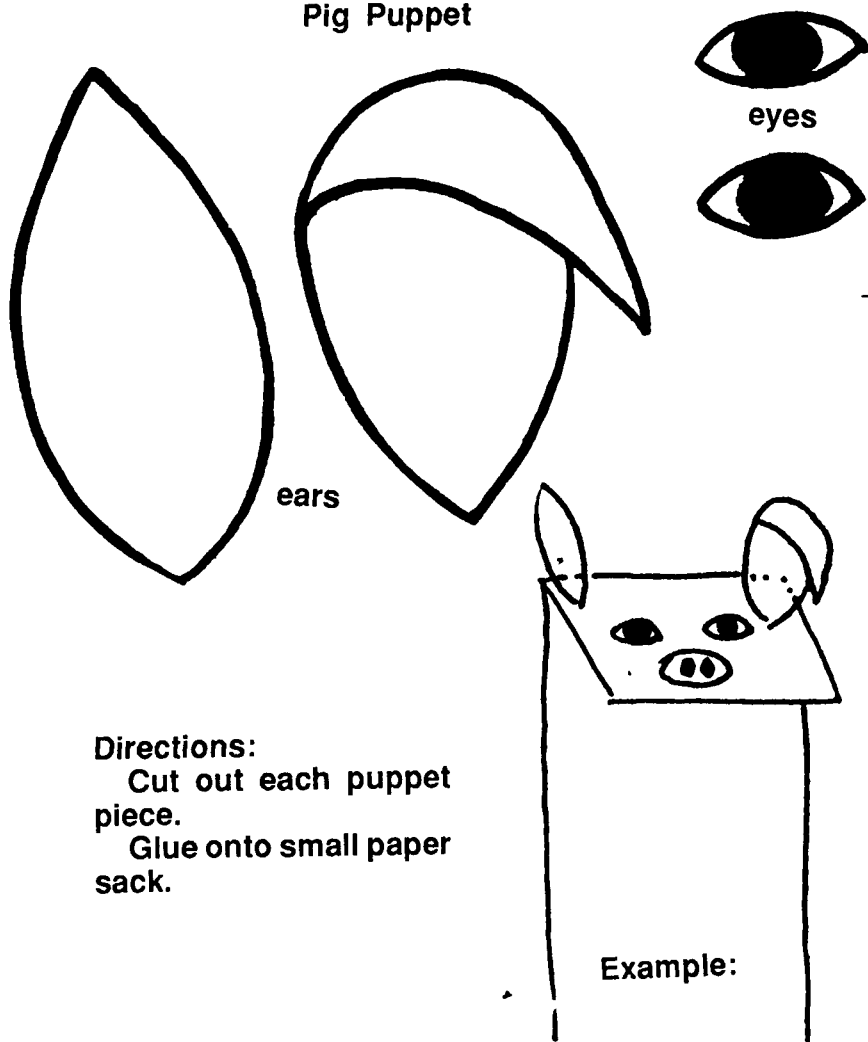

## Pig Puppet

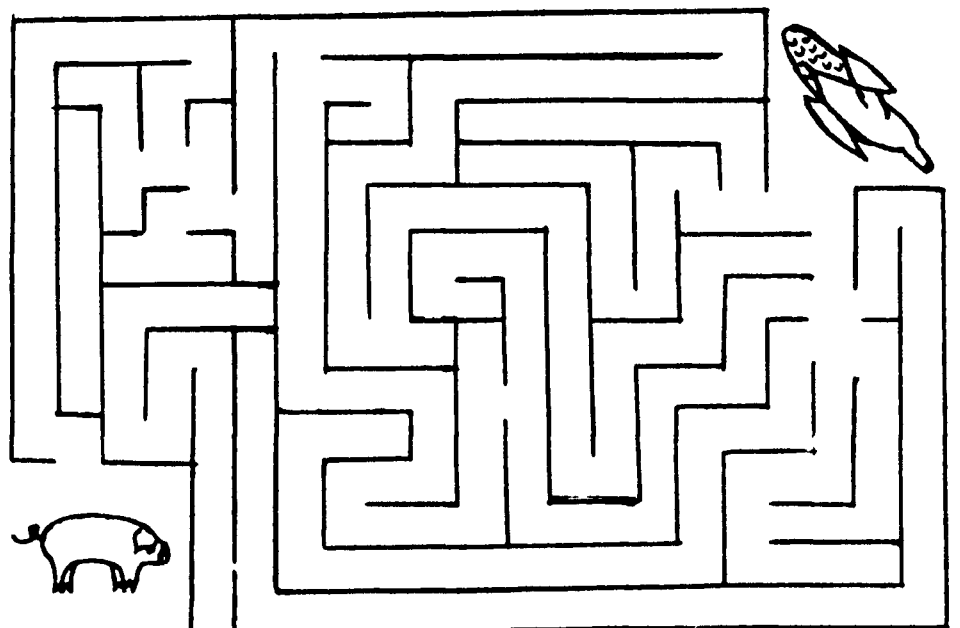


Directions:
