Ask the Old Farmer: I have a 26-year-old brick chimney on an outside wall that was stuccoed 16 years ago. Now the stucco is chipping off in large enough pieces to take about one-third of the brick with it. If I remove the stucco, can I replace it with anything that will save the brick? L. A., Brattleboro, Vt

Your chimney is going to pieces from the inside. Moisture is getting into the brick from the flue side and soaking through to the stucco. You could have the chimney relined, which will let you patch the stucco, or you could have a metal cap installed that will let smoke out but prevent water from getting down the flue.

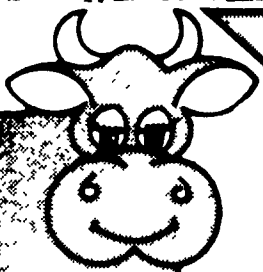
