

Lancaster's Fair Season Wraps Up On A Cold Day In Manheim

MANHEIM (Lancaster) - It was cold day to end Lancaster County's 1988 fair season. The audience for the Manheim Fair dairy shows held October 6 shivered each time the sun slipped behind one of the many clouds in the sky and the resulting chill was a reminder that winter was not far away. Tom Zartman of Ephrata won the Brown Swiss junior championship with his senior calf and earned the champion showmanship award. In the Jersey breed Brian Sauder swept all but one of the championship titles. It was Robyn Groff capturing the reserve junior title which prevented a clean sweep.

In the Guernsey division a newcomer to the county appeared in the list of winners. The Henisee family moved here from New Jersey earlier this year. They topped the

Guernsey competition at the Elizabethtown Fair. In the youth Guernsey show John Henisee won the junior championship while his brother Jason took the reserve junior title. Crystal Brubaker's junior yearling exhibited by Lowell Brubaker took the junior championship in the open Guernsey division.

Show judge Alan Hostetter went to his 4-year-old class for both of this grand and reserve grand champions belonging to Heather Henisee and Dave Henisee. Best udder in the breed went to the reserve grand champion and second place 4-year-old belonging to Dave Henisee. Angela and Elizabeth Spickler of Mount Joy dominated the Ayrshire competition.
