WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; OCT. 6-12, 1988. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE UNEVEN, \$2.00 HIGHER TO \$3.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$3.00 HIGHER. SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA THIS WEEK WERE 75 CENT TO \$3.75 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. THE BOXED BEEF CUT-OUT VALUE ON TUESDAY WAS \$112.57 UP \$1.68 FROM LAST

TUESDAY.
COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1 PERCENT ABOVE LAST WEEK BUT 2 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 4 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.
VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO FIRM. VEAL AND CALF SLAUGHTER WAS 4 PERCENT HIGHER THAN LAST WEEK BUT DOWN 8 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS

WERE 14 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.
LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 HIGHER. LAMB SLAUGHTER WAS 3 PERCENT ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 2 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN LAST YEAR.
