HARRISBURG — Pennsylvania again dominated the Belgian Horse Show at the 1988 Keystone Livestock Exposition, which concluded a successful five-day run last week at the State Farm Show Complex.

Lewis & Gail Biddle Family of Boalsburg, CENTRE COUNTY, exhibited the show's grand champion stallion, "Seneca Valley Jeff," who advanced through the two-year-old stallion class. Gary & Ellen Holdsworth of Claysville, WASHINGTON COUNTY, won

the reserve grand champion ribbon with "Orndorff's Marcus Royale," best of the four-year-old and older class.

"Orndorff's Highland," after capturing first in the four-year-old and older mare class, won the grand champion mare ribbon for Orndorff Belgians of Waynesburg, GREENE COUNTY.
