FUTURES MARKET TRENDS GRAIN AND LIVESTOCK

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ACRES CORN UPDATE: Corn futures closed lower on lower cash prices and slack export news. Present flow of corn from the CCC and a trickle from producers is keeping ample supplies in the pipeline given present demand. Commercials were net buyers and spreading active. Wheat and beans were supportive for corn near the close.

ACRES SOYBEAN UPDATE: Soybean futures closed slightly higher with deferreds gaining on the nearbys. November lost ground relative to deferreds on fears of large deliveries. Support for beans at the close

reflected rumors of USSR interest in South American soy products. Commercial buying also supported prices as did recent price action suggesting a bottom. Meal closed mixed amid a late rally.

ACRES WHEAT UPDATE: Wheat futures higher today and near session highs on news of additional export bonus bids from China and Egypt. Bids were for nearterm shipment which boosted the December and March contracts. Commercials today's trading on overnight export bonus activity.

ACRES CATTLE UPDATE: Live cattle futures closed higher

today in light trading. Today's feature was short-covering as yesterday's sharp losses were thought to be overdone. Cash trade today was mostly steady also supporting futures. Some positioning prior to Friday's Cattle on Feed report was noted. Feeder cattle futures also closed higher boosted by an increase of the latest cash index price. Advances were limited by ideas cash prices would weaken nearterm.
