VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA AND THE MIDWEST WERE STEADY WITH SOME UP AND DOWN VARIATIONS DURING THE WEEK IN THE MIDWEST. SLAUGHTER WAS THE SAME AS THE WEEK BEFORE BUT 16 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 15 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA AND THE MIDWEST WERE UNEVEN, 50 CENT LOWER TO \$2.50 HIGHER. LAMB SLAUGHTER WAS THE SAME AS LAST WEEK AND 5 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOGS IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT LOWER AS THE MID-WEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO 75 CENT LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE UNEVEN, 50 CENT TO \$1.75 HIGHER EXCEPT LOINS WHICH

WERE \$5 00 LOWER. PORK PRODUC-TION WAS 4 PERCENT ABOVE LAST WEEK AND 9 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN LAST YEAR.

THE SOUTHEAST VIRGINIA HOG MARKET CLOSED 50 CENT LOWER THAN LAST WEDNESDAY WITH BARROWS AND GILTS, US 1-4 200-240 LBS \$36.50-37.50 PER CWT.

AT HARRISONBURG, LYNCHBURG AND TAPPAHANNOCK HOG PRICES WERE STEADY THAN LAST WED-NESDAY AT \$36.00-39.00 PER CWT. SOWS RANGED \$23.00- 25.00 AND BOARS \$20.00 PER CWT.
