WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA. MARKETS IN REVIEW; OCT. 27-NOV. 2, 1988. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA AUCTION WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$5.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE FIRM TO \$2.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$4.00-5.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.50-2.00 LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$4.00 LOWER WHILE THE MIDWEST MARKET WAS \$2.00 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS DOWN LESS THAN 1 PERCENT FROM LAST WEEK BUT 2 PERCENT HIGHER THAN A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 11 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA AND THE MIDWEST WERE STEADY WITH SOME UP AND DOWN VARIATIONS DURING THE WEEK IN THE MIDWEST. SLAUGHTER WAS THE SAME AS THE WEEK BEFORE BUT 16 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 15 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA AND THE MIDWEST WERE UNEVEN, 50 CENT LOWER TO \$2.50 HIGHER. LAMB SLAUGHTER WAS THE SAME AS LAST WEEK AND 5 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOGS IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT LOWER AS THE MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO 75 CENT LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE UNEVEN, 50 CENT TO \$1.75 HIGHER EXCEPT LOINS WHICH

WERE \$5.00 LOWER. PORK PRODUCTION WAS 4 PERCENT ABOVE LAST WEEK AND 9 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN LAST YEAR.

THE SOUTHEAST VIRGINIA HOG MARKET CLOSED 50 CENT LOWER THAN LAST WEDNESDAY WITH BARROWS AND GILTS, US 1-4 200-240 LBS \$36.50-37.50 PER CWT.

AT HARRISONBURG, LYNCHBURG AND TAPPAHANNOCK HOG PRICES WERE STEADY THAN LAST WEDNESDAY AT \$36.00-39.00 PER CWT. SOWS RANGED \$23.00-25.00 AND BOARS \$20.00 PER CWT.
