

Alfred College Hosts Veterinarian Conference

ALFRED, NY — Veterinarians from eight states and Canada took part in the recent International Veterinary Nutrition Conference hosted by Alfred State College.

The four-day conference drew participants from Pennsylvania, Ohio, Vermont, Connecticut, New Jersey, Maryland, California, and New York State as well as Canada, according to coordinator Thomas J. Cannon, assistant professor in Alfred State's Plant and Animal Science Department.

Topics included forage quality, DHIA record access, feeding program data collection, feed cost analysis, and feeding system

analysis. The conferees also visited local farms.

Besides Professor Cannon, other Alfred State College faculty members making seminar presentations were Terry Tucker, Richard Hoffman, and Ronald Stutzman.

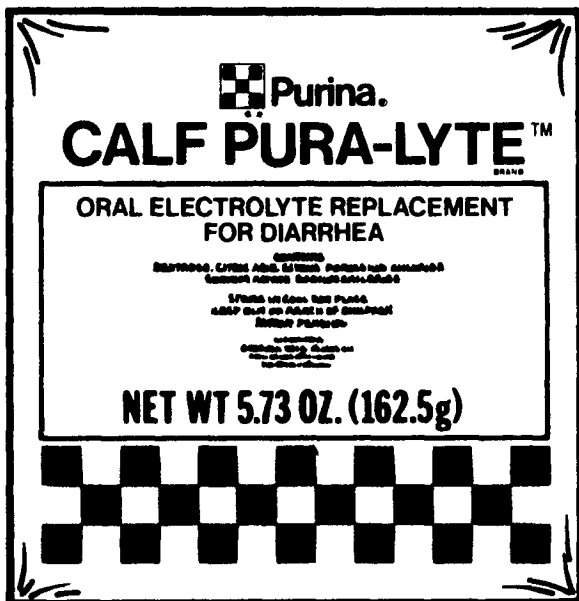

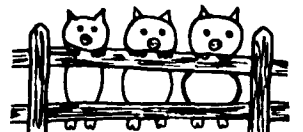

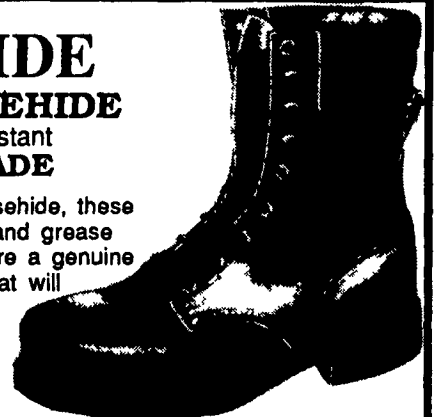
