# Powell Assumes World Simmental Federation Post

BOZEMAN, MT. — Lloyd Powell of Kirkland, Wash., has been elected to the position of senior vice-president of the World Simmental Federation. Powell, currently a member of the American Simmental Association Board of Trustees and a past Board Chairman, was named during the WSF World Congress, held recently in Munich, West Germany.

Dr. Otmar Foger, director of the Austrian Flechvieh Society, was elected to the President's position, and Dr. Peter Massman, director of the South African Simmental Society, was named junior vice president.

Powell, who recently concluded a two year term as WSF junior vice president, is a 1955 graduate of the University of Oregon. He is the president and chief executive officer of Lloyd Powell & Associ-

ates and maintains a Simmental-Simbrah cattle operation near Bend, Ore. He's a member of the ASA Publications Board and also serves as a Trustee for the University of Oregon.

Powell sees a couple of immediate goals that need to be addressed during his term in office. "To embrace more countries in the World Simmental Federation", he said. "And secondly, to provide more services to our members, which in turn would give the WSF increased credibility, status, and usefulness."

The 1990 WSF Congress will

be held in Switzerland, while the 1992 Congress will be held for the first time in the United States. The Dallas-Fort Worth area has been designated as the location for the U.S. meeting.

There are nineteen member nations representing five continents in the World Simmental Federation, including the United States, Canada, Argentina, Brazil, Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, Zimbabwe, Austria, France, West Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom, and Yugoslavia.

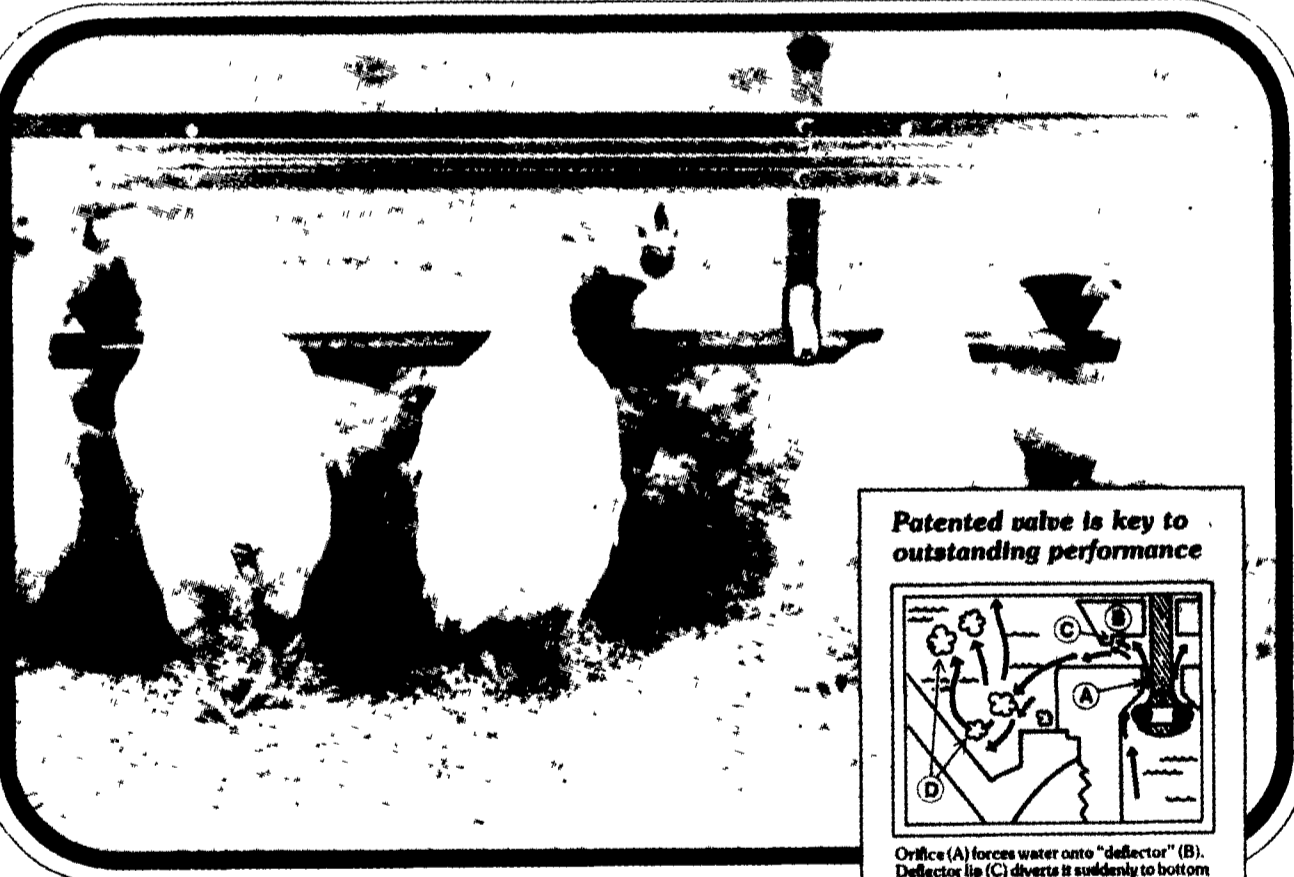

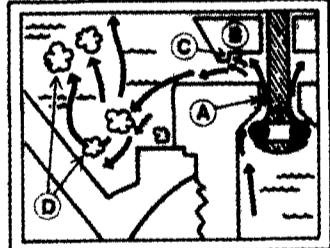

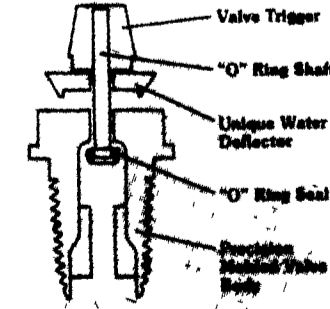


**Patented valve is key to outstanding performance**


