 • Can be used for grain at lower populations in full season areas.



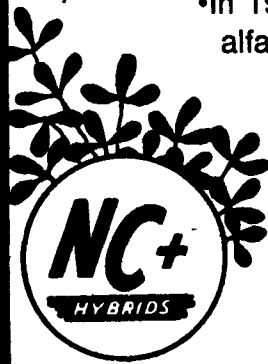
