"Bob has been an auctioneer for 25 years," says his wife Cindy, "and has been around livestock and farmers most of his life."


Isennock, the youngest of 11 children, grew up in a dairying family; and his parents have operated two dairy farms in Maryland.

"This was an opportunity that came along," Cindy says of the acquisition of the New Park livestock sales business.
