

Forest Service To Review Fire Management Plans

WASHINGTON, D.C. — The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Forest Service will begin an immediate review of fire management plans that allow lightning-caused fires in national forest wilderness to burn under certain conditions, Acting Secretary of Agriculture Roland R. Vautour announced today.

He said plans will be revised as necessary to ensure they meet requirements recommended by an interdepartmental fire policy review team in a report issued last month and published in the December 20 Federal Register.

The secretaries of agriculture and the interior established the team to analyze federal fire management policies and their application in national parks and wilderness, and to recommend policy changes which address the concerns of citizens and public officials about the management of

fires in Yellowstone National Park and surrounding national forests in 1988.

"The review team's findings and recommendations are sound and very important to the improvement of our fire management program," said Forest Service Acting Chief William L. Rice. "Although there will be a 60-day public comment period on the report, it is appropriate for us to immediately initiate a review of our plans. By starting now, we can ensure that our policy will be in place and fully understood before the fire season begins in the West."

Rice and Forest Service Chief
F. Dale Robertson has directed
that all naturally occurring fires on
national forests be suppressed
until fire management plans have
been reviewed and approved. In
addition, he directed the agency's
regional foresters to make certain
their organizations are fully prepared to manage prescribed natural fire programs.

"Although our prescribed natural fire program has been successful since first implemented in 1972, the severe fire season this year pointed out some areas which need strengthening," Rice said. "We will certainly take advantage of this opportunity to make a good program better."


