

Franklin Co. Agent Receives Lion

KAUFFMAN STATION -- A Nittany Lion statue was presented to an unsuspecting Senior County Agent at the Franklin County Extension Association's 71st Annual Meeting January 20.

William A. Reagan received the award from Bob Anderson, Lancaster County, of the Pennsylvania Association of County Agricultural Agents. The Lion was given by the state association in recognition of the national award Reagan received in North Carolina in August when he was given the Distinguished Service Award by the National Association of County Agricultural Agents.

Joe Middour, president of the local association, recognized two directors retiring from the association's Board of Directors after serving two three-year terms. Carl Wenger, representing Letterkenny Township, and Isaac Horst, representing Lurgan Township received certificates of appreciation for attending at least twothirds of the board meetings during their tenure.

Featured speaker for the event, held at Kauffman's Community president of the association, and member of the Pennsylvania Council of Cooperative Extension Associations. Golden discussed the Volunteer Information Provider Program, a service built on the extension network and designed to give information to caregivers of the rural elderly. Nineteen Pennsylvania counties are covered by the program.

John Z. Shearer, County Extension Director, introduced the six multi-county staff that serve Franklin County. Shearer explained that two years ago, the extension administration decided to utilize people who are expert in narrow subject areas by having them cover a large area. While no multi-county agent is based in Franklin County, several are available to local citizens.

Introduced were Laurence Yager, Agricultural Marketing, who covers eight counties; Mitch Woodward of Lancaster County, Nutrient Management; Alan Michael, Dauphin County, Horticulture, who covers seven counties; Tom McCarty, Water-Quality, six counties; Roland Freund, Farm Management, four counties; and William Kleiner, Center, was Linda Golden, past Commercial Fruit, three counties.



Senior County Agent William Reagan was presented with a Nittany Lion in recognition of the Distinguished Service Award he received in August from the National Association of County Agricultural Agents.
