CASH GRAIN AND SOYA COMPLEX PRICES LOWER. PROFIT TAKING ON FUTURES CONTRACTS BROUGHT ALL ITEMS UNDER PRICE PRESSURE. ALSO WHEAT PRICES INFLUENCED BY CONCERN OVER POSSIBLE RESERVES BEING SOLD ON THE CASH MARKET. DOWNWARD PRESSURE ON CORN PRICES ALSO SUPPORTED BY THE LACK OF EXPORT NEWS. INFLUENCE FROM WEATHER NOT AS MUCH OF A FACTOR TODAY AS YESTERDAY.

EXPORT NEWS: ALGERIA BOUGHT 50,000 TONNES U.S. HARD RED SPRING WHEAT UNDER EBP FOR APRIL SHIPMENT. TAIWAN BOUGHT 30,000 TONNES OF U.S. NO. 2 YELLOW SOYBEANS FOR FEB/MAR. TAIWAN IS TENDERING FOR 10,000 TONNES OF NO. 2 YELLOW SOYBEANS FOR FEB/MAR SHIPMENT. YUGOSLAVIA IS IN THE MARKET FOR 20,000 TONNES OF U.S. SOYMEAL. TUNISIA IS TENDERING FOR UP TO 23,000 TONNES OF OPTIONAL-ORIGIN SOY PELLETS FOR MARCH SHIPMENT.

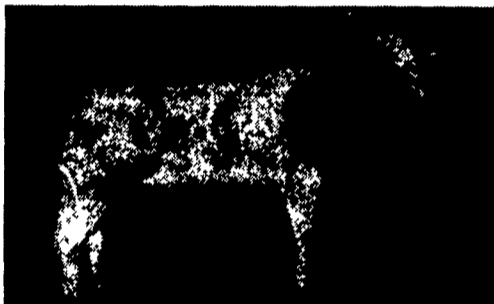
