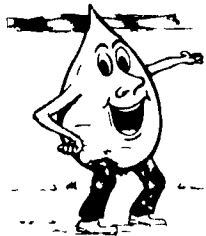
Gary Fielding, #5 Lake Ariel, had the leading dairy herd in the Wayne County Dairy Herd Improvement Association for the month of November, according to the Cooperative Extension Service. The herd of 33 Holsteins had a rolling herd average of 20,678 pounds of milk and 811 pounds of butterfat.

Other top herds were: Kevin Burleigh, #1 Pleasant Mount, 19,940 milk and 742 fat; Rowe Brothers, #2 Honesdale, 18,714 milk and 716 fat; Highland Farms, St. Rt. Honesdale, 19,877 milk and 705 fat; E. W. Lepro, #2 Thompson, 18,590 milk and 693 fat; Jack & Ella Chyle, Pleasant Mount, 20,248 milk and 691 fat; Charles P. Dennis, #2 Honesdale, 18,538 milk and 687 fat; Kinghill Farm, Starrucca, 17,266 milk and 676 fat; Dave Noble, #4 Honesdale, 19,333 milk and 674 fat and James Slocum, #3 Susquehanna, 16,748 milk and 667 fat.

The cow completing the highest lactation of 305 days or less during the month of November was a three-year-old Holstein owned by Gary Fielding, #5 Lake Ariel. "Amanda" produced 24,649 pounds of milk and 1085 pounds of butterfat.

Other top producers were "Tracia" owned by Gary Fielding, 25,088 milk and 1,037 fat; "Candy" also owned by Gary Fielding, 22,091 milk and 962 fat; "10" owned by James Yatsonsky, #2 Honesdale, 18,528 milk and 895 fat; "Angel" owned by Jack and Ella Chyle, #1 Pleasant Mount, 22,454 milk and 872 fat; "Dandy" owned by Gary Fielding, 22,895 milk and 866 fat; "Debbie" owned by Jack and Ella Chyle, 27,323 milk and 865 fat; "Bea" owned by Gary Fielding, 23,340 milk and 848 fat; "Extra" owned by Jack and Ella Chyle, 19,938 milk and 842 fat and "Camie" owned by Dave Noble, #4 Honesdale, 25,934 milk and 832 fat.
