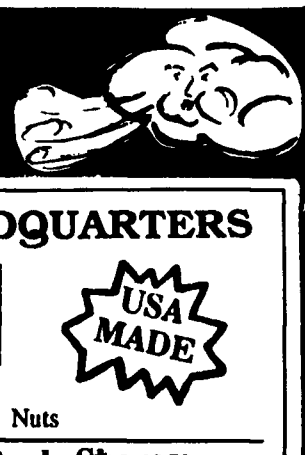

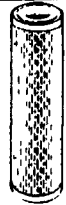

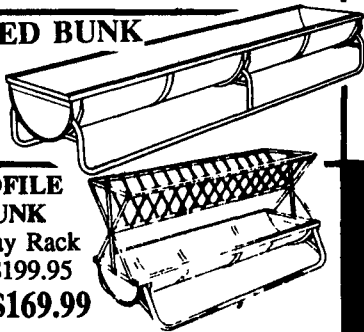

**Wayne County  
Dairy Days**

HONESDALE (Wayne) — The 1989 Wayne County Dairy Day will be held Thursday, March 9, 1989, from 9:30 a.m. - 3:15 p.m. in the Wayne County Veterans' Memorial Armory located on Tryon Street, Honesdale, according to co-chairmen Garry Rutledge and David Hudy. Dairy Day is held each year to provide dairy farmers with new technology, and to recognize the importance of the dairy industry to our local economy. It is sponsored jointly by Penn State Extension and area farm businesses and organizations.

The program will feature Paul Nichols, American Dairy Association, who will give a slide presentation on producing milk in Europe as compared to the U.S. His talk will include information on the use of milk and manure quotas in Europe. Another highlight of the program will be a panel discussion on current dairy herd health problems in Wayne County by Dr. John Burlein, Dr. Henry Nebzydoski, and Dr. Douglas Caucci. In addition, a slide presentation recognizing Master Farmer — Ellis Dix will be presented. Remarks by Gillian Kieff, Wayne County Dairy Princess will be made.
