Announces Resignation Of Executive Director PAFC

HARRISBURG — The Board of Directors of the Pennsylvania Association of Farmer Cooperatives (PAFC) has accepted the resignation of Kathy Gill as executive director, according to President Robert M. Dever.

Dever noted that Gill had served as PAFC executive director for four years. She was the first full-time director for the cooperative trade association since the '60s.

Gill resigned to move to the Seattle area, where she joined her husband, Dan Plinski. In late 1988, Plinski accepted a new position with Mazza Cheese Co., Orting, WA. Gill plans to continue working with agricultural cooperatives, communications and leadership development as a consultant.

Prior to joining PAFC, Gill

worked for four years as communications manager for Inter-State Milk Producers Cooperative, Southampton, PA (now Atlantic Dairy Cooperative) and eight months in the press office of the Pennsylvania Agriculture Department.

"I have truly enjoyed my time in Pennsylvania for the past nine years," Gill said. "Saying goodby to the cooperative movement in the Middle Atlantic, to the Northeast dairy industry and to Pennsylvania is not easy. But new challenges await in the Pacific Northwest."

PAFC is currently undergoing reorganization, partially in the wake of Gill's resignation. The Board expects to announce a new director in late March or early April.




