

said. The Tunkhannock laboratory is located at the Agriculture Department's Region 3 headquarters in Wyoming County. The Summerdale lab and Region 6 headquarters are in Cumberland County, across the Susquehanna River from Harrisburg.

The move became possible when the U.S. Department of Agriculture assumed responsibility for market-cattle tests, which had been conducted by the department Tunkhannock.

This allows two technicians and a laboratory assistant at Tunkhannock to perform the Johne's Disease testing in addition to continuing a milk-ring test, Wolff said. Johne's Disease affects the animal's general health and milk production but it is not passed along to humans.

The Summerdale facility, which is the department's central animal diagnostic laboratory, has strained to keep up with an increasing workload brought on by increasing producer concern about Johne's Disease, Wolff said.

Consequently, there is a backlog of Johne's testing, which is a timeconsuming process requiring up to 14 weeks to complete.

Wolff said the increased testing will bring the department a step nearer to a goal ofeventually certifying herds as testing free of Johne's Disease.
