

(Continued from Page A28) have "drastically affected the amount of milk available for product trade, quota impositions casein manufacturing."

He predicted a decline in CCC purchases, from 8.8 billion in 1988 to an estimated 5-7 million pounds in 1989. Most of that will be butter. With cheese prices in a slide, Paddock predicted CCC cheese purchases at about half the 1987/88 levels.

France's De Wilde perhaps summed up the feeling of the foreign dairy representatives, commenting that, while American dairymen have not really been players on the world market, the rest of the world should look out if they decide to do so.

Ag Secretary Wolff Announces New Lab

HARRISBURG
(Dauphin) — State

Agriculture Secretary
Boyd E. Wolff
announced recently that
testing for John's Dis-
ease, a chronic bacterial
ailment affecting cattle,
will be expanded and
moved to the depart-
ment's laboratory in
Tunkhannock.

Transfer of the test-
ing, now performed at
the Summerdale labora-
tory, will enable the
department to improve
delivery of John's
diagnostic service and
make better use of the
facilities, equipment
and personnel at both
laboratories, Wolff
said.

The Tunkhannock
laboratory is located at
the Agriculture Depart-
ment's Region 3 head-
quarters in Wyoming
County. The Summer-
dale lab and Region 6
headquarters are in
Cumberland County,
across the Susquehanna
River from Harrisburg.

The move became
possible when the U.S.
Department of Agricul-
ture assumed responsi-
bility for market-cattle
tests, which had been
conducted by the
department at
Tunkhannock.

This allows two tech-
nicians and a laboratory
assistant at Tunkhan-
nock to perform the
John's Disease testing
in addition to continu-
ing a milk-ring test,
Wolff said. John's
Disease affects the ani-
mal's general health
and milk production but
it is not passed along to
humans.

The Summerdale
facility, which is the
department's central
animal diagnostic
laboratory, has strained
to keep up with an
increasing workload
brought on by increas-
ing producer concern
about John's Disease,
Wolff said.

Consequently, there
is a backlog of John's
testing, which is a time-
consuming process
requiring up to 14
weeks to complete.

Wolff said the
increased testing will
bring the department a
step nearer to a goal of
eventually certifying
herds as testing free of
John's Disease.
