

"We started farming on our own in January of 1983. We were feeding a traditioinal 40% concentrate and rolled grain mix and our R.H.A. was 16,200 lbs. milk and just over 600 lbs. fat. In November of 1984 we went on the Masíer Mix Protek concentrate program. This program, along with better breeding and A.I. management, boosted the herd average 2400 lbs. of milk in the first year. So, by November, our R.H.A. was 18,600 lbs. milk and 671 lbs. fat."

"Then, a year and a half ago, we started topdressing the Master Mix Protek 1890's. The 1890's really help a cow milk to her genetic potential. The cows don't necessarily peak higher, but with the 1890's they hold their peaks a lot longer. They also keep their condition. The cows love the 1890's. In fact, they'll go for the 1890's before the rolled shelled com."

We now have a R.H.A. of 20,252 lbs. milk and 715 lbs. fat. Nine cows out of 41 were milked over 100 lbs. in April. We are pleased with breeding and our 13.0 calving interval which isn't too bad considering the way they're milking. A good feeding program and good A.I. and breeding management has gotten us to the point where we are working with better cows, because we can now cull what we want to!"
