 A consignment of Lewis W. Berkley of Berlin sold for a final price of \$5,300. HJH Berkline Trifecta Dora-ET was purchased by Gina L. Berkley of Berlin. This 1986 cow is sired by Nowerland Trifecta, an Excellent 91 pt. whose sire is Carlin-M Ivanhoe Bell, a Gold Medal Proven Sire. The paternal granddam is Nowerland Valiant Jacky an Excellent, who is also a Gold Medal Dam. On the maternal side of the pedigree, the dam is Miss Chief Mark Dot-ET, a Very Good 85 pt., whose sire is Walkway Chief Mark, a Very Good 87 pt. Gold Medal Sire.

Going for \$5,100 was Lyn Haven Melvin Melinda, a consignment of Alex Claypoole of Worthington. Her sire is the well-known Mel-Est Valiant Irose Melvin, an Excellent 93 pt. Gold Medal Proven Sire. Her dam is Lyn-Haven Tony Jamie, a Good Plus 82, whose sire is Marshfield Elevation Tony, a Very Good 88 pt. Gold Medal Proven Sire. Lyn Haven Malvin Melinda was purchased by the Melvin Syndicate.

Jar-Am-Hills Calypso Dee Dee, a consignment of Gregory and Kathy Toy of Kittaning went for \$5,000 to Fred Strouse of Centre Hall. Born in December of 1988, this heifer placed first in the intermediate calf class in the Pa. State Holstein Spring Show in 1989. Sired by Applenotch Valiant Calypso-ET, an Excellent, 93 pt. Gold Medal Proven Sire, her dam is Mahoning-Acres Sarah Beth, A Good Plus 82 pt., whose sire is Marshfield Elevation Tony, also a Gold Medal Proven Sire.

Also selling for \$5,000 was Imperial C Supreme Creation-ET, a consignment of Imperial C Breeders of Saegertown. Purchased by Junge Farms, Inc., of New Tripoli, this February, 1989, heifer calf is sired by the famous Glenafton Enhancer. Her dam is Rynd-Home Valiant Cutie, an Excellent, 91 pt. whose lifetime production is 110,640M, 3.7F. The dam's sire is S-W-D Valiant, an Excellent, 95 pt. Gold Medal Proven Sire.

A final bid of \$4,650 sealed the purchase of Queens-Manor Enhance Repose-ET, a September, 1988, heifer calf. Consigned by Justin E. Doeberienner of Jamestown and purchased by Jacque Houde of Quebec, she also is sired by Glenafton Enhancer. Her dam is Houdale Temp Rachael, an Excellent 93 pt. who was an All-American Two-Year-Old in 1984 and an All-Canadian Two-Year-Old in the same year.

Antrim-Spring Star B Rita-Twin, an April, 1988, heifer calf. Sired by Hanover Hill Starbuck, her dam is Antrim-Spring Lyn Regal, an Excellent, 90 pt. whose fourth-year production was 21,430M, 4.0F. This calf was consigned by Harold F. Crider of Chambersburg.

A consignment of Queens-Manor and John Park of Westford brought \$3,600. The pedigree of this September, 1988, heifer boasts eight generations of Very Good or Excellent Dams. Queens-Park Countess Mandy is sired by Fisher-Place Mandingo-Twin; her dam is C Romandale Count-Ivy-ET, a Very Good, 87 pt. whose fifth-year production was

27,568M, 4.0F, 3.3P.

Bringing \$3,500 was an offering of Oakleigh Holsteins of Mercersburg, Oakleigh Trifecta Heather. This heifer's pedigree combines Ivanhoe and Enhancer lines, with Nowerland Trifecta being her sire and Oakleigh Farm Enhancer Hope her dam. The dam is a Very Good, 86 pt. with a second-year production of 25,930M, 4.3F.

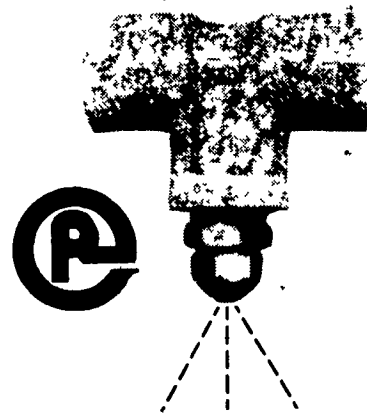

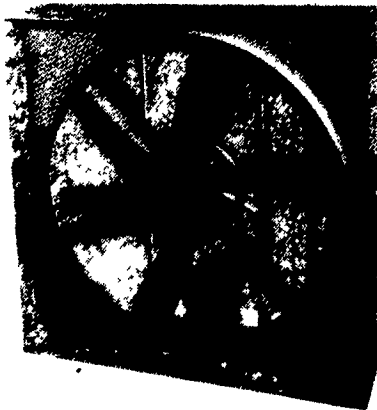
