

Agricultural Land Preserve Board Members Named

HARRISBURG — Gov. Robert P. Casey today announced the appointment of five members to the newly established State Agricultural Land Preservation Board, which is responsible for administering a \$100 million program to save prime Pennsylvania farmland.

Gov. Casey's appointments to the board were York County Commissioner Lorraine Hovis; William Hughes of Meridian

Bank in Berks County; Louise Midla, a farmer from Marianna, Washington County; Bernard Hankin of the Eagleview Corp. Center; and Jefferson Township Supervisor Russell Nickel.

Under a law signed by Gov. Casey last December, the land preservation board will administer a statewide program to purchase agricultural easements. Farmland protected through easement

purchases cannot be developed. Other members of the board include the secretaries of agriculture, community affairs and environmental resources, along with the dean of Penn State's College of Agriculture and four members of the General Assembly.

Legislative appointments to the board are made by leaders of the House and Senate. House Minority Leader Matthew J. Ryan (R-Delaware) named Kenneth Rutt of Quarryville, Lancaster County, to the board; House Speaker James J. Manderino (D-Westmoreland) named Frederick Slezak of New Alexandria, Westmoreland County; and Senate Minority Leader Robert J. Mellow (D-Lackawanna) named James Cap-

pucci of Mehoopany, Wyoming County. Senate President Pro Tempore Robert C. Jubelirer has not yet made his appointment to the 17-member board.

Secretary of Agriculture Boyd E. Wolff, who serves as chairman,

scheduled the first board meeting for April 19 in the Agriculture Building in Harrisburg.

The board is authorized to certify county preservation programs and allocate money for easement purchases in each county.
