president in 1988, as well as being a National Distinguished Junior Member in 1988. She has also been an active 4-H and FFA member, winning numerous awards in both organizations.

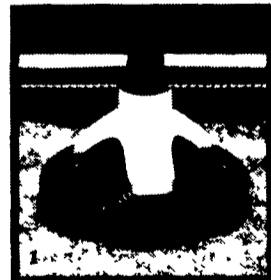

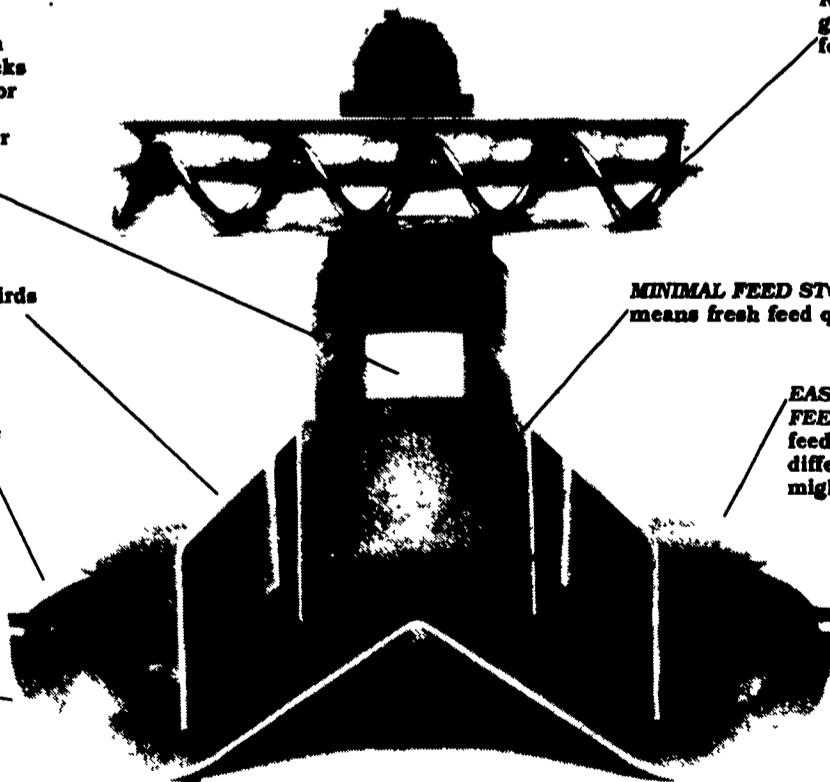

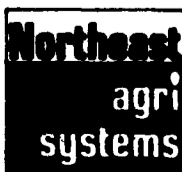
