MARKETS IN REVIEW; MAY 4-10, 1989. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MIXED, \$1.50 LOWER TO \$2.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.25-2.25 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 75 CENT HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY \$1.00-3.00 HIGHER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY \$1.00-1.50 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 3% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT LESS THAN 1% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUND HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$3.00-4.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES HAD CHOICE AND PRIME FED VEAL STEADY, GOOD AND CHOICE VEAL WAS UNTESTED. VEAL AND CALF SLAUGHTER WAS 3% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 5% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 12 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN LAST YEAR.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE

STEADY TO \$7.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY. LAMB SLAUGHTER WAS 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.

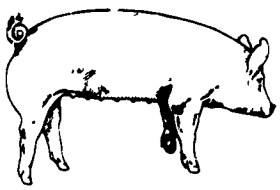
