**Acres Hog Update:** Live hog futures reversed direction again this week and managed to close from unchanged on the February option to 62 points higher on the July. Buying was in response to spillover from limit gains in all of the pork belly options along with reports of steady to higher midday wholesale product prices. Gains were tempered by higher than expected runs yesterday along with ideas that today's run would also be higher. Today's slaughter at 311,000 compares with last year's figures of 301,000. Bellies were pushed higher by expectations for renewed retail demand for bacon featuring.
