MARKETS IN REVIEW; MAY 11-17, 1989. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED \$250 LOWER TO \$7.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.75 TO \$5.50 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY \$3.25 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 TO 75 CENT HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE UNEVEN \$.75 LOWER TO \$1.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 4% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 7 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$5.00-6.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES HELD FIRM. VEAL AND CALF SLAUGHTER WAS 3% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 12% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN LAST YEAR.

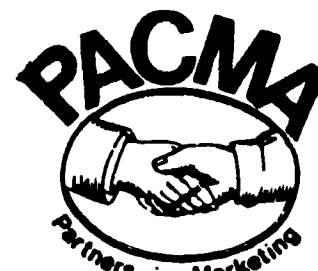
