

Hershey Leads Team

For Moving Barn To Museum

KINZERS (Lancaster Co.) — Arthur D. Hershey, state representative from Chester County, has been selected as chairman for the advisory board appointed by Rough and Tumble Museum for its historic barn moving project.

Other advisory board members include: Senator Gibson Armstrong (Lancaster County); Representative Kenneth E. Brandt (Lancaster County); Gene Hemphill, who is in charge of public relations for Ford New Holland; Lancaster County Commissioner James Huber; Christian Kunzlers Jr., president of Kunzler & Co. of Lancaster; Gerald Lestz, owner of Stemgas Publishing; Richard Vanderberg, engineering manager of Cleaver Brooks, Lebanon; Lloyd Wenger, manager of Wengers Farm Machinery of Myerstown; and Wendall Woodbury, editor of "Our Heritage" on WGAL-TV.

Rough and Tumble Museum, located on Route 30 at Kinzers, has accepted the gift of a German-style bank barn built in 1869. The barn, presently located along the Fruitville Pike north of Lancaster, will be disassembled - with each

piece marked - and reassembled on the museum's grounds. At Rough and Tumble Museum the barn will become an appropriate display setting for many of the pieces of early farm equipment and machinery, originally built nearby, which the museum has collected in its 40-year history.

The barn, given to Rough and Tumble Museum by Robert and Esther Lafever, has served three generations who farmed the land, but its proximity to Lancaster dictates that the land become a setting for lovely single-family homes. Thus the barn, which sits astride what will become a wide residential street, must be moved to a new location or lost forever.

Construction for the foundation of the relocated barn will begin after the August "Threshermen's Reunion," a living-history show that is an annual event of Rough and Tumble Museum and for which it is known nationwide.

Much interest has been demonstrated in a possible "Amish-style" barn raising when the building is reconstructed on the museum's grounds. This event seems likely in the spring of 1990.

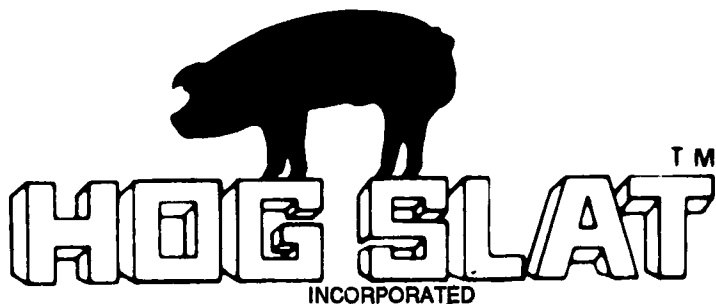

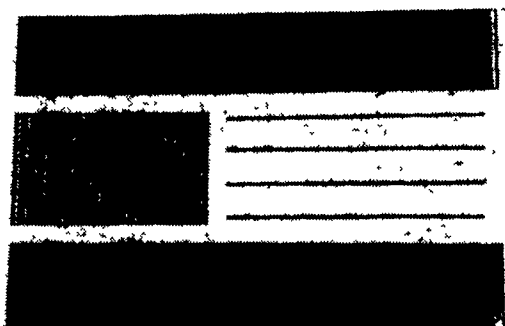
