CORN AND SOYBEAN PRICES LOWER AS RAINS OVER-NIGHT AND PROSPECTS FOR MORE RAIN, PRESSURED PRICES. AFTER ALMOST NIL IN EXPORT ORDERS, SMALL ORDERS, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF WHEAT SALES TO EGYPT, ARE SHOWING UP.
