WHEAT PRICES HIGHER; CORN AND SOYBEANS LOWER ON WEDNESDAY. WHEAT TURNED HIGHER AS SHORT COVERINGS AFTER RECENT DECLINES AND LIGHT BUYING INTEREST BOLSTERED PRICES. HARVEST IS JUST AROUND THE CORNER. CORN AND SOYBEAN PRICES LOWER AS RAINS OVERNIGHT AND PROSPECTS FOR MORE RAIN, PRESSURED PRICES. AFTER ALMOST NIL IN EXPORT ORDERS, SMALL ORDERS, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF WHEAT SALES TO EGYPT, ARE SHOWING UP.

EXPORT NEWS: EGYPT BOUGHT 120,000 TONNES OF SOFT RED WINTER WHEAT FOR \$9/90. SOUTH KOREA BOUGHT 19,500 TONNES OF U.S. WHEAT FOR JUNE/JULY SHIPMENT. JAMAICA BOUGHT 6,200 TONNES OF NO. 2 OR BETTER NORTHERN/DARK NORTHERN SPRING WHEAT, TAIWAN BOUGHT 78,000 TONNES OF NO. 2 YELLOW CORN FOR JUNE SHIPMENT. TAIWAN BOUGHT 30,000 TONNES OF U.S. NO. 2 YELLOW SOYBEANS FOR JUNE.

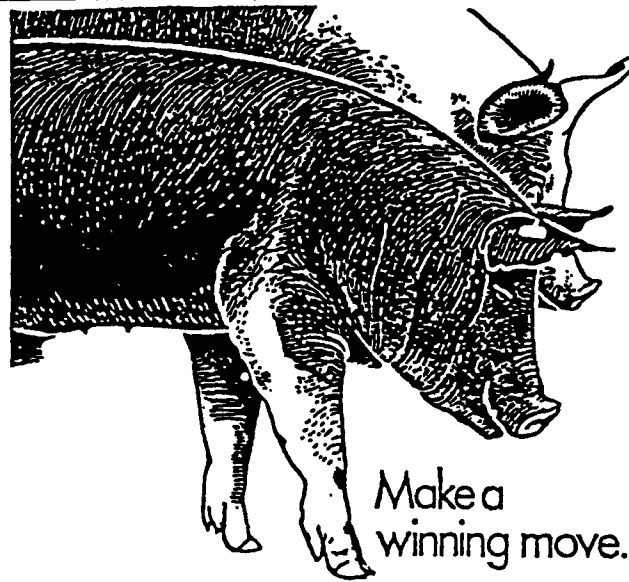
