COMPARED WITH LAST WEEK'S CLOSE-FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS OVER 500 LB. WEAK TO \$2.00 LOWER; LIMITED TEST ON WEIGHTS UNDER 500 LB. STEADY. FEEDER DEMAND MODERATE. SHARP DOWNTURN IN THE FED STEER AND HEIFER TRADE CREATED A BEARISH ATTITUDE IN FEEDER BUYER RANKS. SUPPLY OF FEEDERS OFFERED HERE IN CENTRAL OKLA DURING MAY SHARPLY BELOW LAST YEARS COUNT. LIVESTOCK MOVEMENT OCCURRED EARLIER THAN NORMAL THIS YEAR DUE TO THE GOVERNMENT SET-ASIDE PROGRAM, WEATHER PATTERN AND AVAILABILITY OF FORAGE, AND THE PRICE OF WHEAT. SLAUGHTER COWS STEADY TO WEAK. SLAUGHTER BULLS STEADY. COW AND BULL DEMAND GOOD; SUPPLY LIGHT. RECEIPTS THIS HOLIDAY SHORTENED WEEK 5,200; LAST WEEK 13,059; LAST YEAR 10,687. RUN INCLUDED 85% YEARLING FEEDER CATTLE; FEEDER CALVES 9%; COWS AND BULLS 6%.

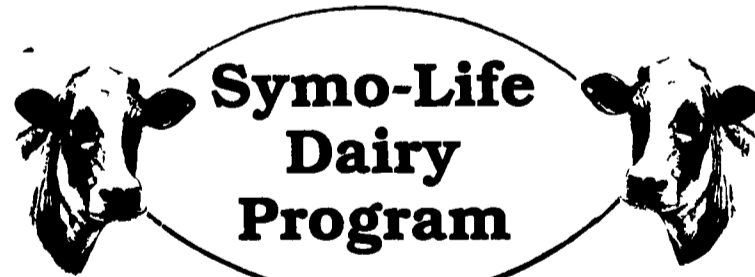
