MARKETS IN REVIEW; JUNE 1-7, 1989. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-6.00 LOW-ER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$7.75-11.50 - LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO 25 CENT LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00 LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$3.75 HIGHER TO \$4.25 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 17% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND LESS THAN 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA AND ACROSS THE COUNTRY COULD NOT BE ESTABLISHED DUE TO THE SMALL NUMBERS SOLD.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.25-6.75 LOWER FOLLOWING MID-WEST PRICES WERE \$3.00-4.00 LOW-ER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 11% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT LESS THAN 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGED DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIR-GINIA WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT

LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE UNEVEN, 25 CENT LOWER TO 50 CENT HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE MOSTLY 50 CENT TO \$4.00 LOWER WITH HAMS SHOWING SOME STRENGTH. PORK PRODUC-TION WAS 17% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 2% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVER-AGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.


