MARKETS IN REVIEW; JUNE 1-7, 1989. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-6.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$7.75-11.50 - LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO 25 CENT LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00 LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$3.75 HIGHER TO \$4.25 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 17% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND LESS THAN 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA AND ACROSS THE COUNTRY COULD NOT BE ESTABLISHED DUE TO THE SMALL NUMBERS SOLD.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.25-6.75 LOWER FOLLOWING MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$3.00-4.00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 11% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT LESS THAN 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGED DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT

LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE UNEVEN, 25 CENT LOWER TO 50 CENT HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE MOSTLY 50 CENT TO \$4.00 LOWER WITH HAMS SHOWING SOME STRENGTH. PORK PRODUCTION WAS 17% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 2% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.
