WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW: JUNE 15-21, 1989. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE UNEVEN \$2.25 HIGHER TO \$3.50 LOWER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$6.25-11.50 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.50-2.00 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE 75 CENT TO \$2.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT LESS THAN 1% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUND HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.00-12.00 HIGHER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY WITH A WEAK UNDERTONE. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 4% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 19% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 20 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-3.00 HIGHER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 2% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 5% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.50-3.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.75-2.25 HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE \$1.00-3.50 HIGHER. PORK PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 6% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.
