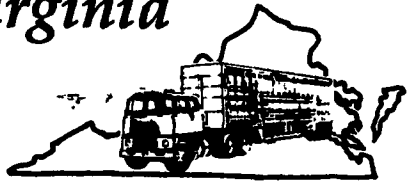

MARKETS IN REVIEW; JUNE 29-JULY 5, 1989. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO FIRM, INSTANCES \$1.00-2.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA THIS WEEK NO TRENDS DUE TO NO REPORT LAST WEEK. MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-2.00 LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE UNEVEN \$2.00 HIGHER TO \$2.00 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS UNCHANGED FROM A WEEK AGO AND 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS HIGHER

THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY \$1.00 LOWER. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 9% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 28 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO 75 CENT HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE FIRM TO 50

CENT HIGHER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 17% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 25 CENT TO \$1.00 LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE \$4.00-5.00 HIGHER EXCEPT HAMS AND BELLIES WERE TO \$6.00 LOWER. PORK PRODUCTION WAS 2% BELOW LAST WEEK AND 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.
