Acres Hog Update: Live hog futures closed mixed again today with the August losing 5 points while December gained 15 points. Trading throughout the session was thin with August confined to a 32 point range. Buying was linked to ideas of decreased movement due to hot and humid weather with selling attributed to expectations for declining cash and wholesale prices. Contract lows were set in the February, April and June options. Bellies were lower again today with new lows set in all months as long liquidation continued to pressure. Fresh bellies continue weak amid dwindling demand and increased production. August hogs settled 5 lower today at \$45.92/cwt after trading in a range from \$45.80 to \$46.12.
