## Preservation Fund

(Continued from Page A1)

Southeastern Pennsylvania has shown the highest support for the program, with five counties in this area contributing \$2.5 million. The southcentral portion of the state also has committed a fair amount of money to preservation. Berks County was the highest contributor followed by Lancaster, Chester. Bucks, and Montgomery counties.

Counties in these two regions will receive 66 percent of the \$25 million in matching funds.

Lancaster, Berks, and Chester counties became the first counties 10 have their county farmland preservation programs approved by the board. The local programs will establish a priority for purchasing easements.

However, before approving these county guidelines, state Ag Board officials added a restriction prohibiting state or county preservation board members from applying to sell their own conservation
