

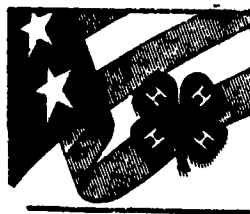

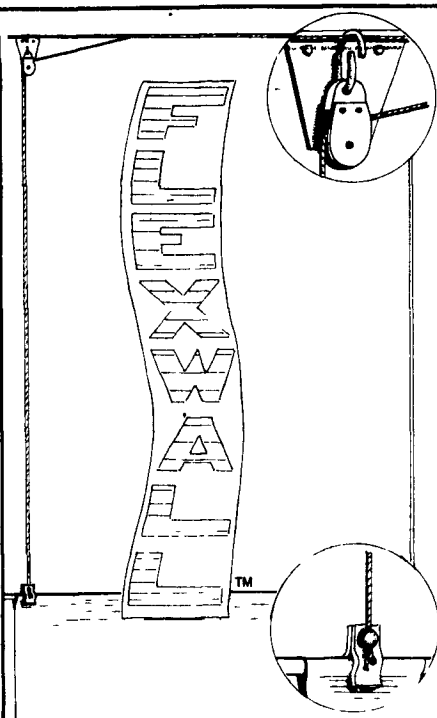

## Horse Bowl, Hippology

On Thursday, July 27th, Lancaster County hosted the District VI 4-H Competition in Horse Bowl and hippology, in preparation for the state competition Aug. 7, 8, and 9 at Penn State University. District VI is comprised of Lancaster, Lebanon, York, Cumberland, Dauphin, Adams and Franklin Counties. Horse Bowl Teams are made up of four members, who compete as a team, as well as individuals, and are scored on how many correct answers they give to questions asked having to do with horses. Questions range from trivia to quite technical in nature. The Horse Bowl competition was conducted by Zoann Parker, Lancaster County 4-H Agent, and her summer-time assistant, Chris McCharon.

Hippology literally translates to study of the horse, but as a competition is comprised of a four-part competition involving judging, identification, testing and problem solving. Knowledge of all aspects of the horse's world is required. Overseeing the 16 sta-

tions of identification were Rose Fellenbaum and Saranna Miller, both leaders in the Boots and Saddle and the Horsin' Around 4-H Clubs. Results of the Hippology Station competition are as follows: in order, Seniors: Melissa Harris, Lancaster; Amanda Wine-ske, Lebanon; Michelle Slay-baugh, Lebanon; Andrea Zeger, Franklin; Jennie Olweiler, Lancaster; Kelly Shaffer and Kara Gerhart, Franklin; Whitney Christen, Lancaster; and Camille Long, Lancaster.

In the Junior Division, all contestants were from Franklin County, and the results in order are as follows: Beverly Miller, Larissa Mellott, Heather Mellott, Collette Collins, Sarah Dietrich, and Martha Dietrich.

Aug. 7, 8, and 9 teams in Horse Judging, Horse Bowl and Hippology from all counties across the state will compete at Penn State University. Winners will then be eligible in the Senior Divisions to compete on the National level.

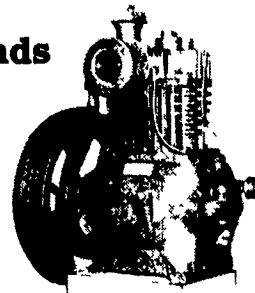
