Iowa, Angus breeding cattle.

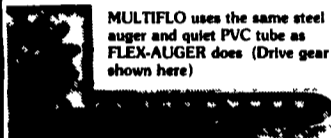
-Harold H. Neill, Corning,

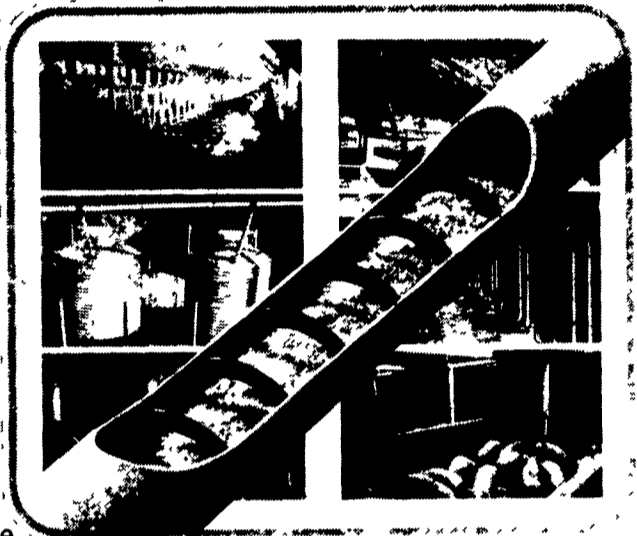

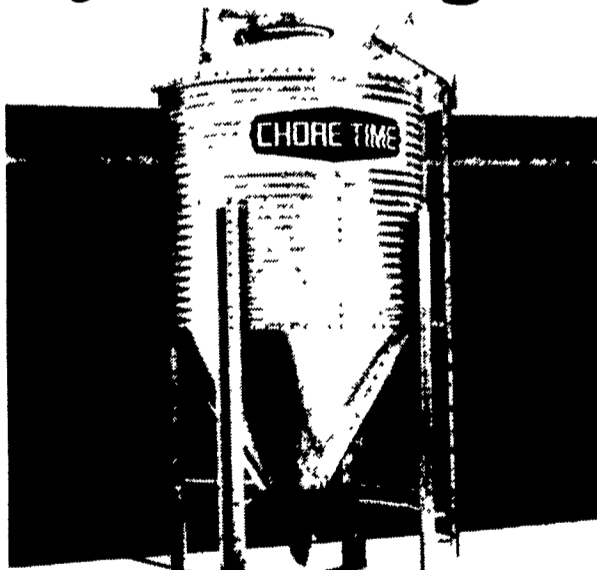
